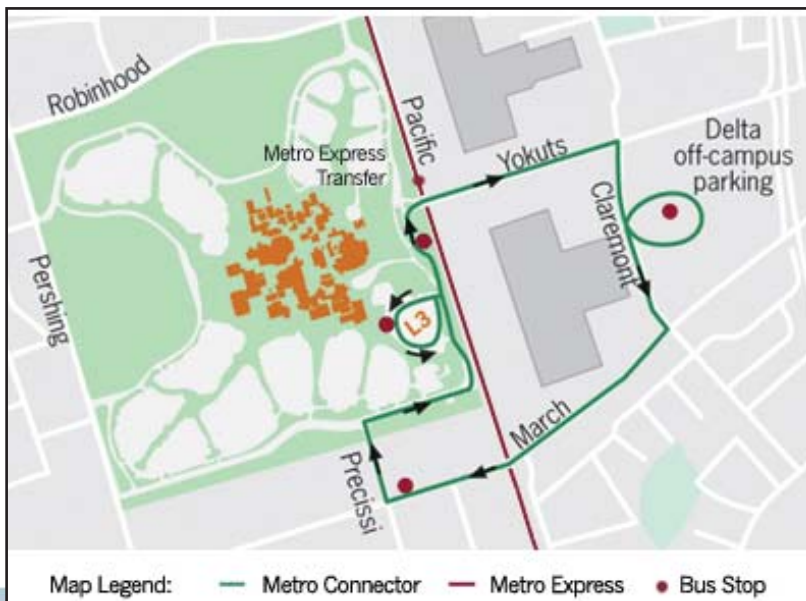
Construction activity has been in high gear over the summer. Off-Campus Parking

Fall Semester is beginning and making accommodations for the increased parking load combined with intermittent reduction in available spaces due to construction will require patience and flexibility by all. While the anticipated parking issues are an unavoidable byproduct of maintaining construction schedules, they were planned for and steps have been taken to mitigate the impact. To that end, arrangements for interim off-site parking have been made.

Effective August 14th, offsite parking will be available at the Circuit City parking lot located at the corner of Yokuts and Claremont. This parking lot will be serviced by a trolley which will make a round trip from Locke 3 parking lot (in front of the Center for Microscopy and Allied Sciences building) approximately every 12 minutes from 7:30 in the morning until 4:15 in the afternoon. The shuttle will be free. When taking advantage of this offsite parking option, please park in the area designated for college parking only.
